It is a <b>History project</b> 'TIME TRAVEL' (<b>project is attached below</b>) - For this project you can select your favourite topic from History (location and time-period - e.g. Amsterdam during the WW2). I have attached lots of ideas so don't worry if you can't think of one.</li> <li>• You are going to set up your own travel business and create a brochure advertising a trip to your selected location.</li> <li>• <b>Week 1:</b> This week all you need to do is come up with a name for your travel business and select the location to travel to. So that's <b>1) and 2) only</b>.</li> <li>• You will need to research your location and time-period, gather as much information as you can.</li> <li>• Please ensure to use safe search engines for your research - Scoilnet, World Book and Kiddle. Attached Maths File</li> <li>2. Copybook or paper and pencil</li> </ol>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Art – Junk Art</b></li> <li>• Junk Art is 3D art made from materials we don't want or need anymore (recycling).</li> <li>• <b>You might use:</b> toilet rolls, plastic bottles, straws, lollipop sticks, pipe cleaners, tin cans, empty ice cream/butter containers, etc.</li> <li>• <b>You might make:</b> pen/pencil holder, money box, jewellery box, flower pot, photo frame, etc.</li> <li>• Use the attached video for some inspiration.
