<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This week we are going to start reading a novel together. Everybody in all three 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> classes will be reading <b>Warhorse</b>. Even if you have read this before, there will be some activities to complete so it would be a good idea to read the book again. You will be asked to read a certain amount of chapters each week. There will be comprehension questions as well as other activities based on the text.</li> <li>The novel is uploaded on Seesaw.</li> <li><b>Read chapters 1-3 only</b> of Warhorse this week</li> <li>Complete <b>Novel Activity 1</b>. Your task is to design an alternative cover for Warhorse. You should read chapters 1,2 and 3 before doing this. You can do this by printing out the attached worksheet or by drawing this into the copybook you have been using.</li> </ul> <p><u>What you will need:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Warhorse Novel and a copybook</li> <li>Dictionary (or dictionary.com) – If you come across words you don't understand look them up!</li> <li>Pencil/Pen and Colouring pencils</li> </ol>	<p><b><u>Geography</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Country Project</b> - Use the attached file to create a project on a country of your choice. <b>Complete the final section this week-Section 12</b></li> <li>Please ensure to use safe search engines for your research - Scoilnet, World Book and Kiddle.
